





MESSAGE TO OUR NEIGHBORS




In An Emergency Dial: 911










FROWN UPON **SAFETY HAZARDS!**

> Please don't play with matches, lighters, electric heaters or pots and pans that are on the stove. All these things could burn you badly. Instead, try calling a friend, reading a book or playing with your toys. THINK SAFETY!



NEVER climb on chairs or cabinets to reach for something. You could easily slip and fall.

NEVER take medication unless your parents, a doctor or the school nurse gives it to you!

Medicine is NOT candy! It could make you sick.

> **NEVER** leave your toys on the stairs or in the hallway. You could trip over them and hurt vourself. THINK SAFETY!





NEVER play with matches or lighter fluid! They can easily start a fire! Lighter Fluid is POISONOUS!




NEVER use hair dryers near water! DANGER: You could be electrocuted





If someone swallows something dangerous, Quickly DIAL: 911
Always keep the bottle & give it to the ambulance team. They will bring it to the hospital and give it to the doctors.

There are things in your house that you should <u>NEVER</u> eat or drink. Put an "X" over the things that would make you very sick. Put a circle around the items that are safe for you to eat or drink. If you are not sure if an item is dangerous, please ask an adult to help you! Look Carefully!



Your local Ambulance Squad, along with the doctors and nurses at the hospital, may use these tools to find out what's wrong. They will help you feel better as soon as possible. None of the tools shown here will hurt you!
