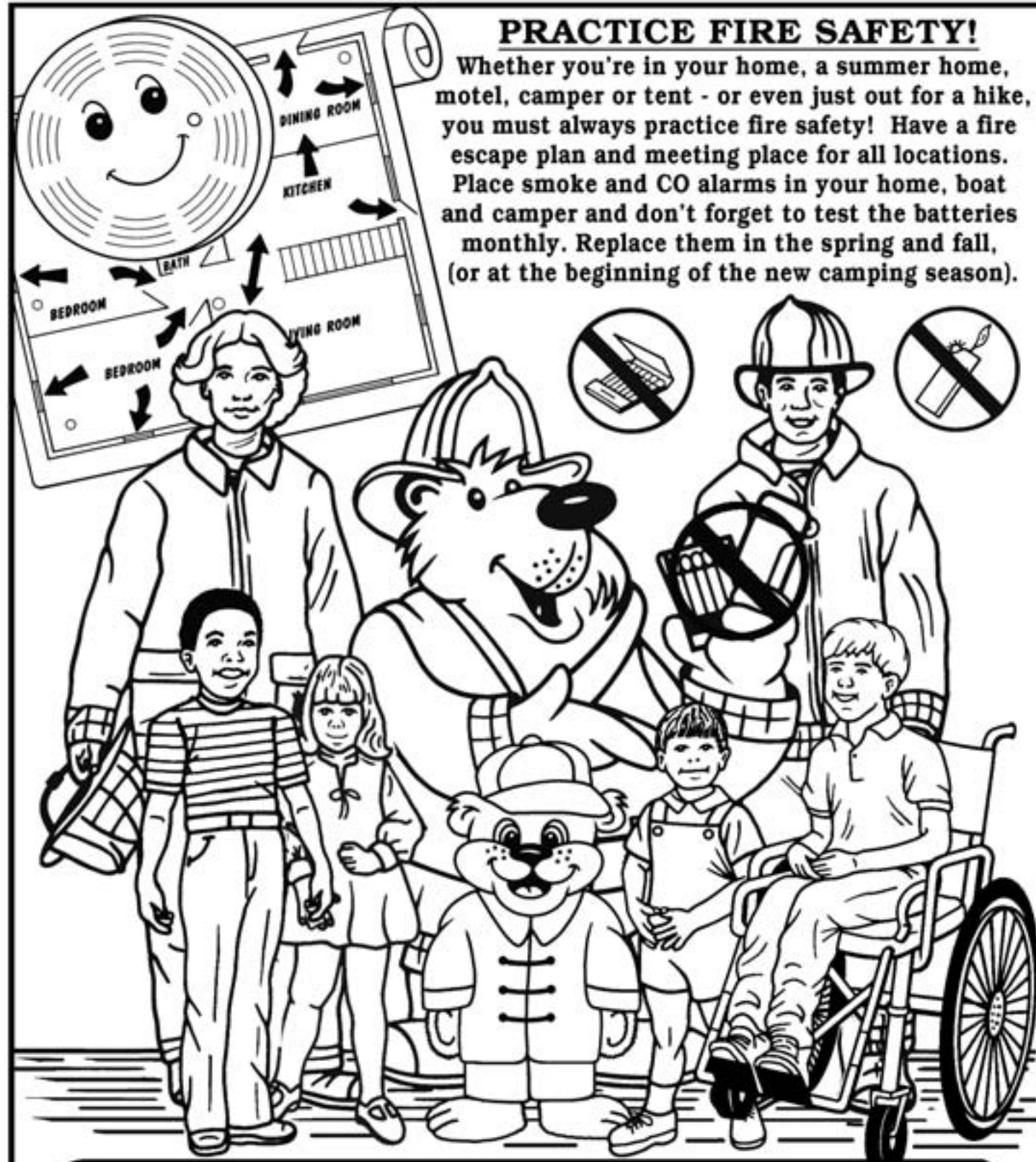

Place smoke and CO alarms in your home, boat and camper and don't forget to test the batteries monthly. Replace them in the spring and fall, (or at the beginning of the new camping season).



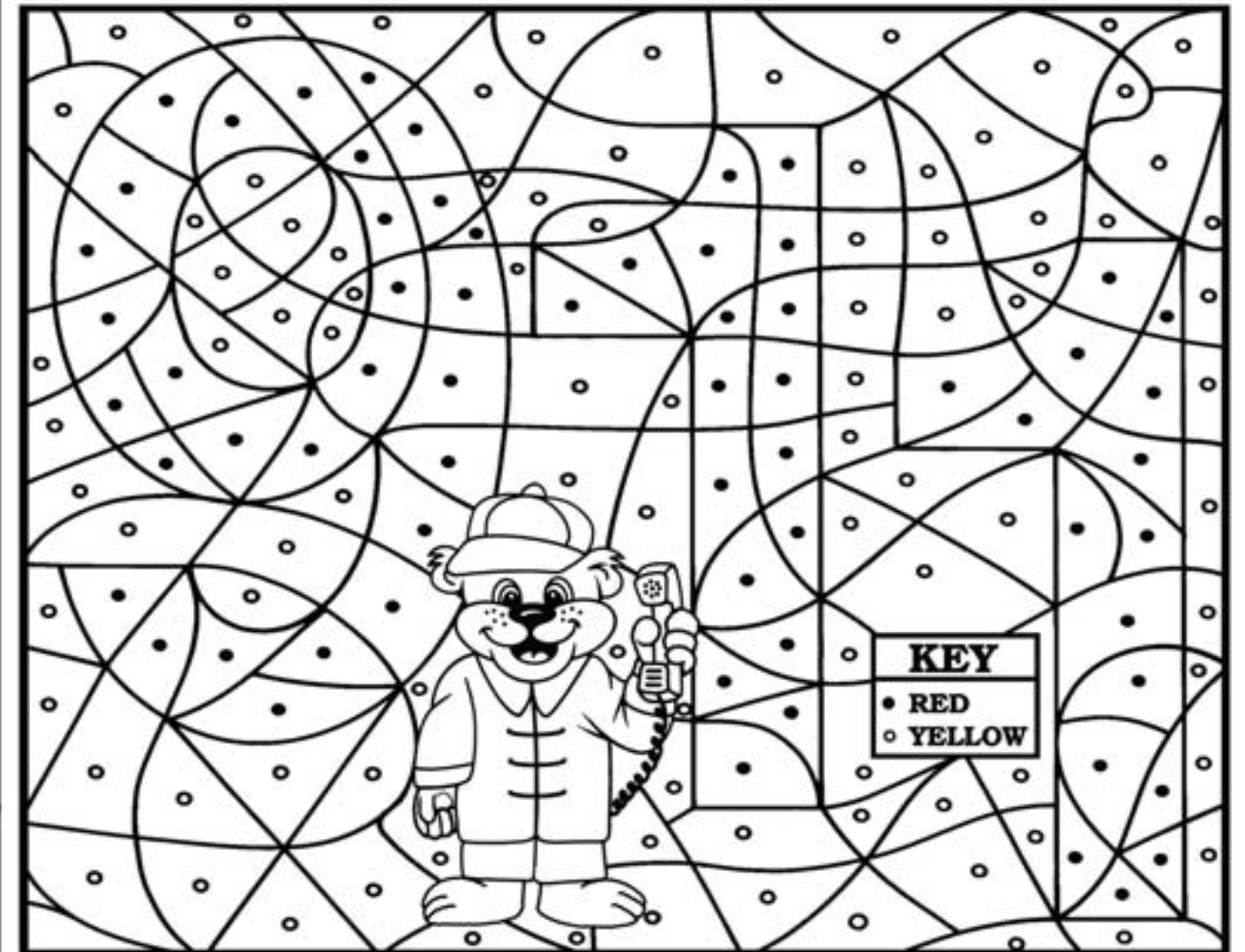
## Learn the Difference Between Good Fires and Bad Fires

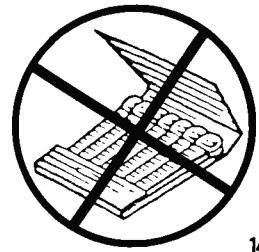
**GOOD FIRES** can cook your food and warm your home. They can also light the candles on your birthday cake or start a campfire! But used incorrectly, **BAD FIRES** destroy things and hurt people. Only adults should use matches, lighters or heating equipment.

**Here's how to DIAL: 9-1-1.** Let your parents show you how to hold the phone!

- First touch the number 9.
  - Then touch the number 1.
  - Then touch the number 1 again.
- The Dispatcher will answer. Give the Dispatcher the information they need to send help to you.

**Stay Calm and Speak Clearly!** Do Not Hang Up Until the Dispatcher Tells You To!

**WILDFIRE FACTS!** Contact 9-1-1, the local fire department or the Park Rangers if you notice an unattended camp-fire!

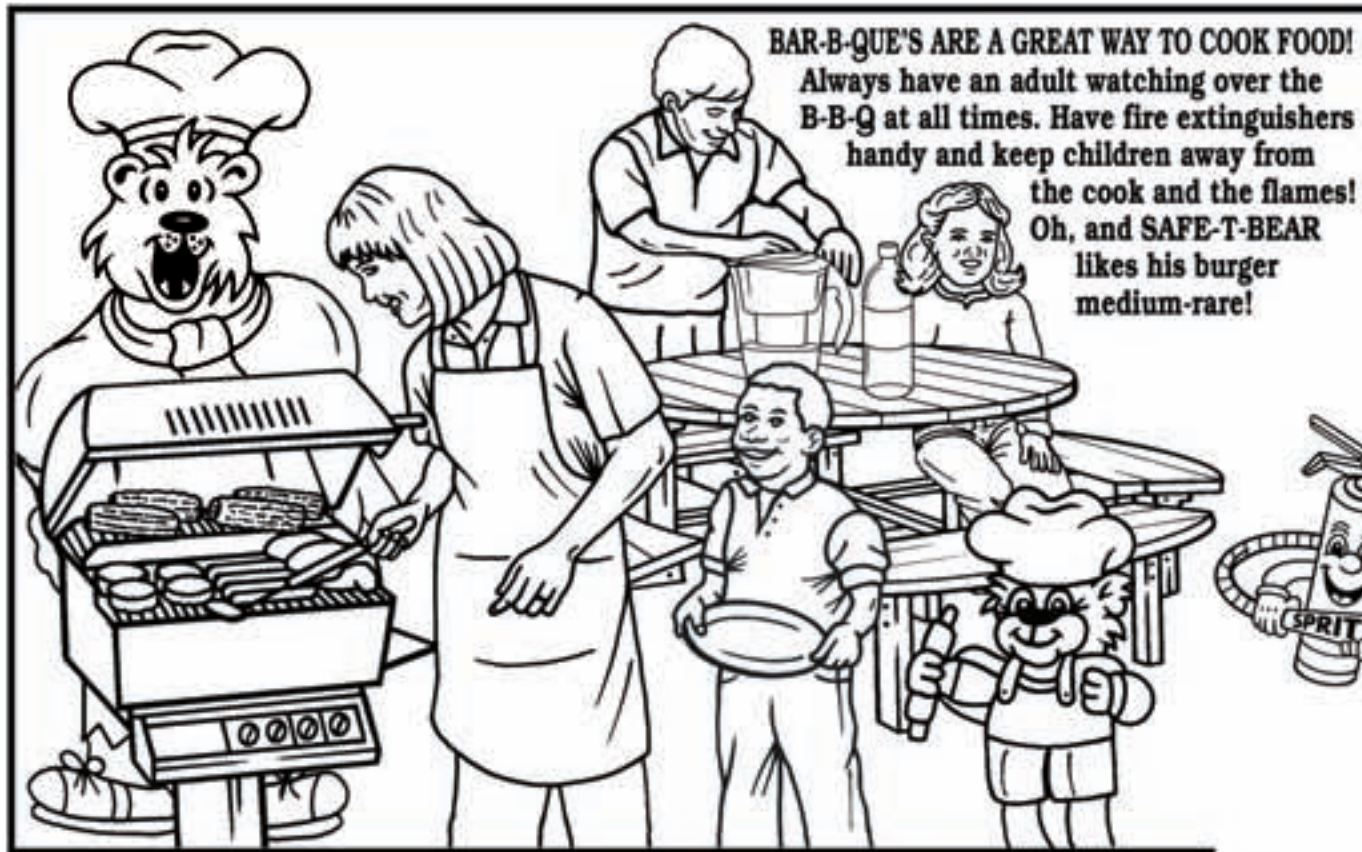
Wildfires are a big danger to people that live near forests, open land, mountains or wooded areas. They occur on every continent except Antarctica! Other names for wildfires are forest-fires and brush-fires. Some of these fires are caused by lightning strikes, but four-out-of-five forest fires are man-made! Tossed cigarettes, matches, fireworks and camp-fires that have not been fully extinguished are the main causes.

**WILDFIRE SAFETY TIPS: Don't Wait If You're Told To Evacuate!**

Wildfires move very fast, especially if there are strong winds to spread them. They can do a lot of damage in very little time to both nature and homes. If you are ever near a wildfire and you are told to evacuate - *Don't Hesitate*. Know two evacuation routes a head of time. Gather your family, your pets and your emergency go-bags and **EVACUATE!** Have an out of area place to meet in case you are separated.



**BAR-B-QUE'S ARE A GREAT WAY TO COOK FOOD!**  
 Always have an adult watching over the B-B-Q at all times. Have fire extinguishers handy and keep children away from the cook and the flames!  
 Oh, and **SAFE-T-BEAR** likes his burger medium-rare!

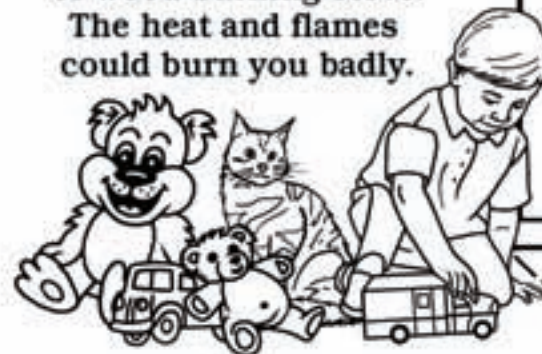

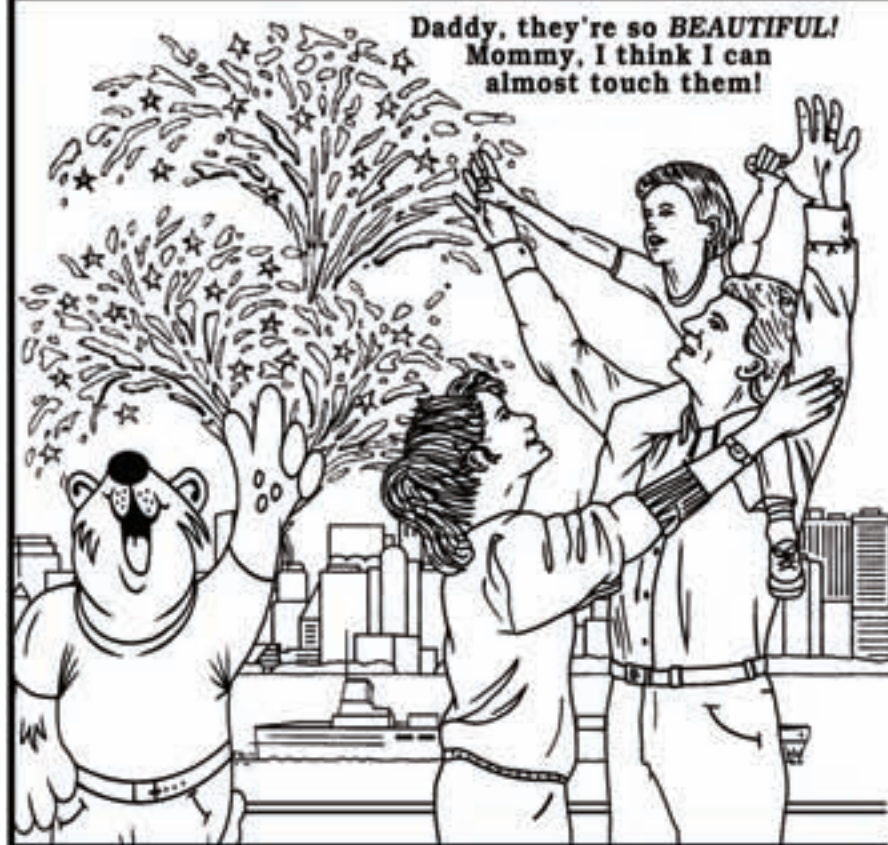


**PLAY WHERE IT'S SAFE!**

Don't play in the areas around an oven, fireplace or wood-burning stove. The heat and flames could burn you badly.

**CAMPFIRE SAFETY**

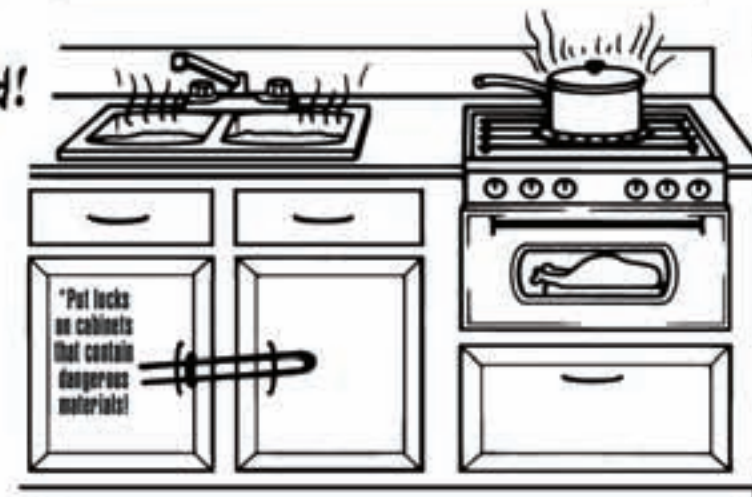
Build fire on flat ground, away from overhanging trees  
 Clear area of all leaves and woody debris  
 Ring your fire area with rocks  
**NEVER LEAVE FIRE UNATTENDED!**  
 Keep Water & Shovel on hand  
 Put fire out at first signs of increased winds and change in its direction  
 To put out fire, Drench with water, Stir, then drench again; stir ashes, drench under and around your ring of rocks  
 "Cold Trail": with the back of your bare hand, touch entire fire area for heat. Drench again until the fire is **DEAD OUT**

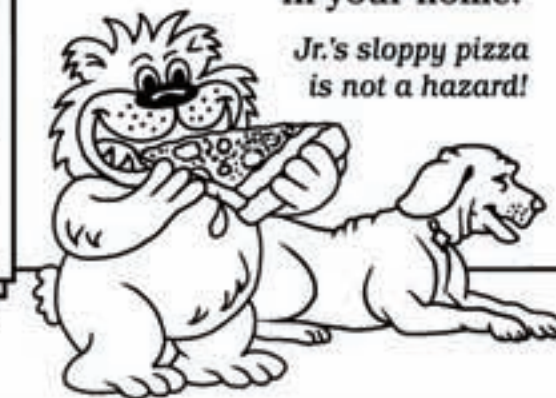

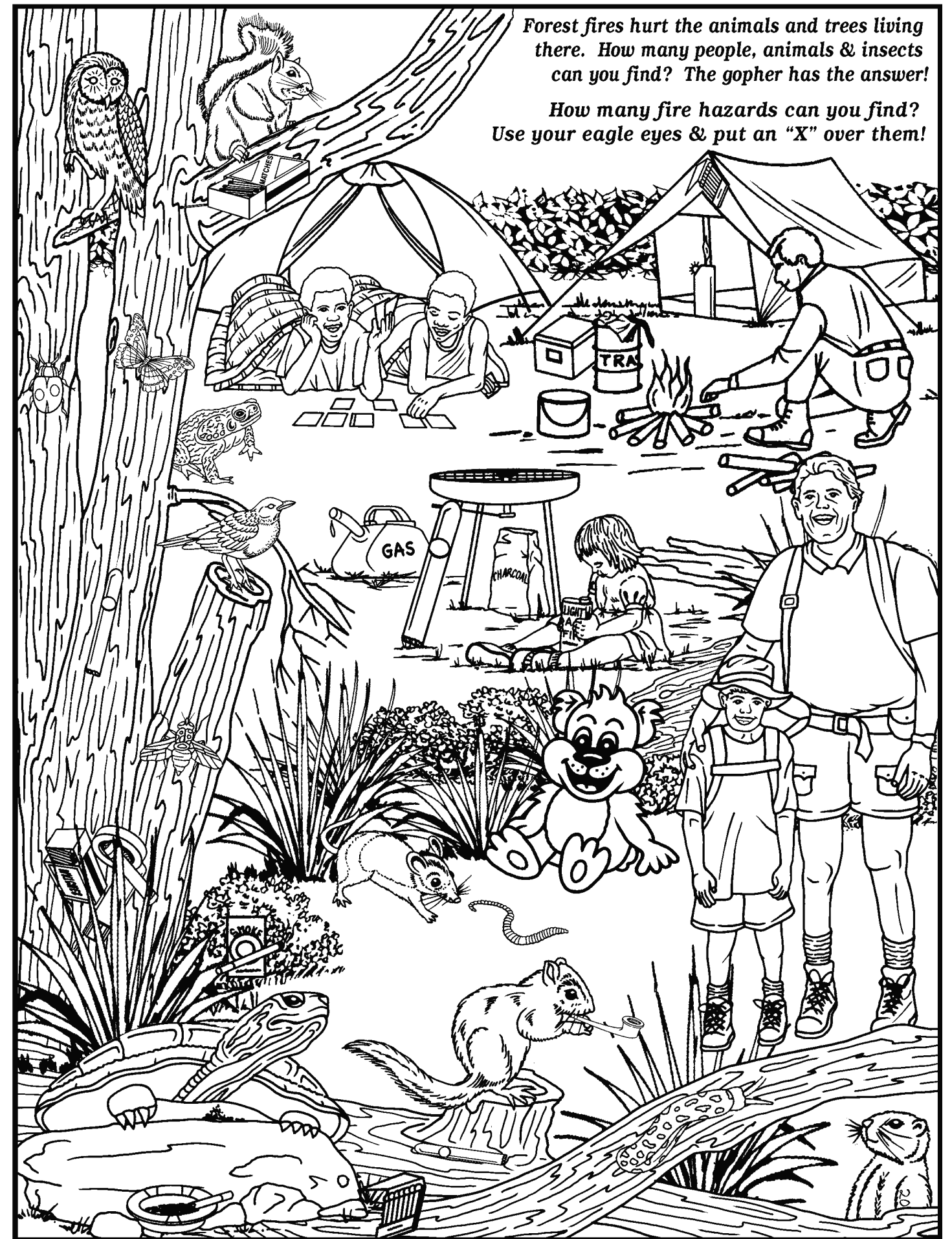
**FIREWORKS ARE FUN - GO WITH THE PROS!**

Last summer alone, nearly 10,000 youngsters were treated for fireworks injuries. Fireworks are not toys! They are dangerous and unpredictable explosive devices! **STOP, DROP, ROLL!**



If your clothes catch on fire, STOP... DON'T RUN! Running will only fan the flames and make them worse. DROP TO THE FLOOR! Then, ROLL around to smother the flames. If there is a towel or blanket nearby, wrap it around you. Continue to roll around to smother the flames.

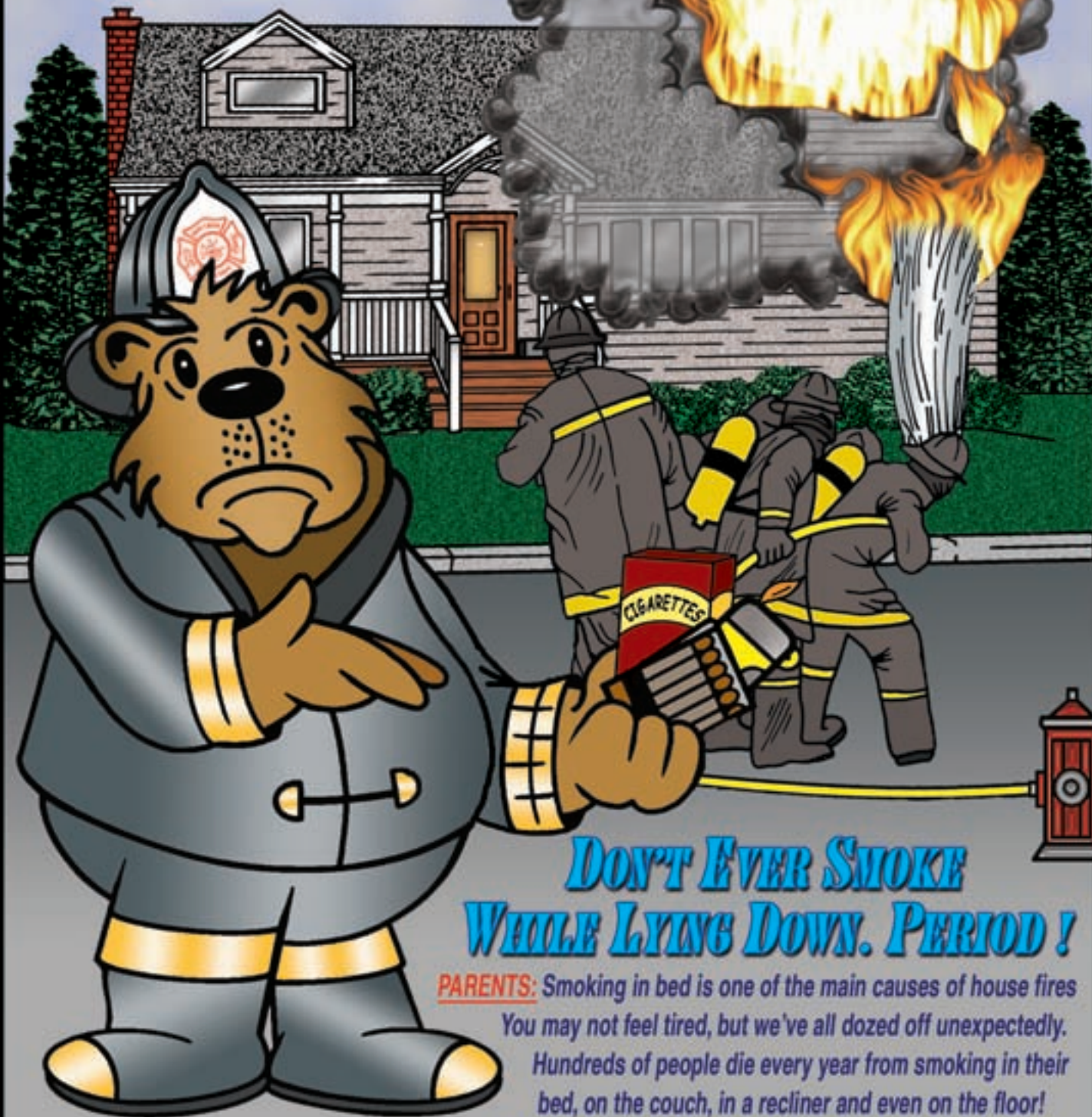
