





EXIT DRILLS IN THE HOME


Your local Fire Department would like your family to develop a Fire Escape Plan. The time you spend now may give you the seconds you need to GET OUT SAFE! This grid has been divided into two sections.


Use one for each floor. Make copies of this if you have more floors. Using a pencil, rough in a layout of your floor plan, showing the location of all windows and doors. Use arrows to show all escape routes. Once your plan is done, go over your lines in pen or marker. Use different colors for the arrows marking your escape routes. Remember: You must know TWO WAYS OUT OF EVERY ROOM! Go to your meeting place once outside.





